Atmosphere: Type I (breathable), Surface water

Points of interest: Tkoku Island



Description: Olcatz was a terrestrial planet with features such as mountains and islands.

Places of Interest

Bacta hot spring

A bacta hot spring was a type of spring. The former Sith known as the Ronin was brought to a bacta hot spring to recuperate following a duel with the Grand Master.

Tkoku Island
